

Our Church is pleased to support CBF Global Missions in moments like these where bearing witness to Jesus Christ takes place through small steps.

After our last newsletter update, several of you wrote to offer prayers for our CHE event in the village - thank you for your prayers... God answered them! Our prayers for the event were primarily for good weather and a good turnout. God generously blessed us with both! We estimate around 150 people showed up for the Family Day on that beautiful Sunday fall afternoon, plus at least 20 volunteers who came to help.

There were football (soccer) matches for the teens and adults. face painting and parachute games for the children. Volunteers cooked a huge pot of herbal tea for everyone to enjoy, and a group of Rom musicians alternated between favorite Roma songs and children's karaoke.

We're grateful so many people came, but this event was not an end. It was only another small step forward in our work in this community. The Community Health Evangelism (CHE) strategy encourages events like this to get to know people in a community and to introduce them to CHE methods and ideas.

Community work like this can move very slowly, especially in places where people distrust outsiders. Through fun activities like this, we pray God would keep opening doors for us to talk about deeper and more important things.


